Intervention Delivery

Q: How flexible are we permitted to be with the delivery of the lesson materials?

A: As long as you deliver the content outlined in the lesson materials, you are permitted to use additional content.

Q: Will the resources be given by you?

A: Yes, the tutors will receive the training materials and teaching materials to deliver the interventions. The teaching material will be provided by Education and Training Foundation.

Q: Who needs to be trained?

A: All tutors in the trial will need to be trained, you should have received information about training via email, please follow the booking links and attend training. If you have any issues, please contact multiply@etioglobal.org.

Eligibility

Q: Is there a minimum cohort size?

A: There is no minimum, but the trial does not suit 1:1 learning.

Q: How many teachers can be involved from one organisation?

A: All teachers who are eligible for the trial may be involved. Ideally, two or more teachers per organisation would participate.

Q: What type of Health and Social Care Level two course are accepted?

A: Your Health and Social care course will be a diploma or certificate awarding course. Unfortunately for this trial, apprenticeship courses are not eligible.
